The Pavilion Café and sports facilities have been closed temporarily in accordance with government guidance and will reopen when we are advised that we can do so.

Our administration team have been working incredibly hard at home to put the charity in the best place to come out of the other side of this unprecedented situation and be ready to resume the vital services we provide for our community.

On Monday 6th April OCRA will start a temporary cessation of operations and will place the administration staff on furlough. Therefore our normal communication lines will not be in operation until the staff return.
